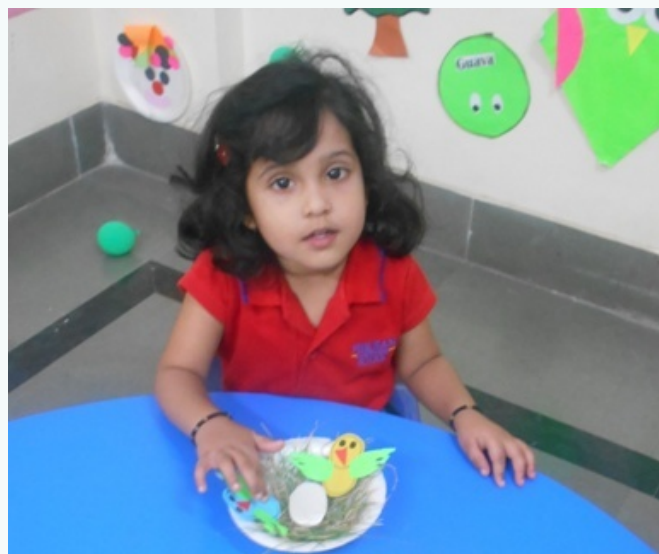
Birds Around Us
