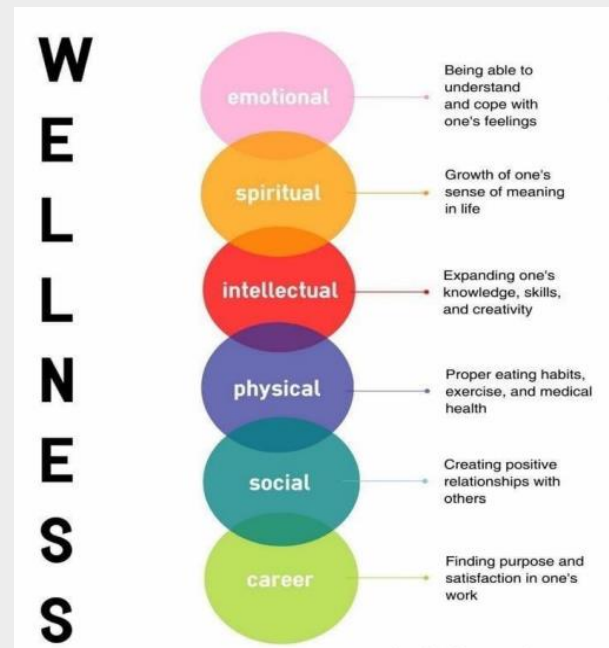

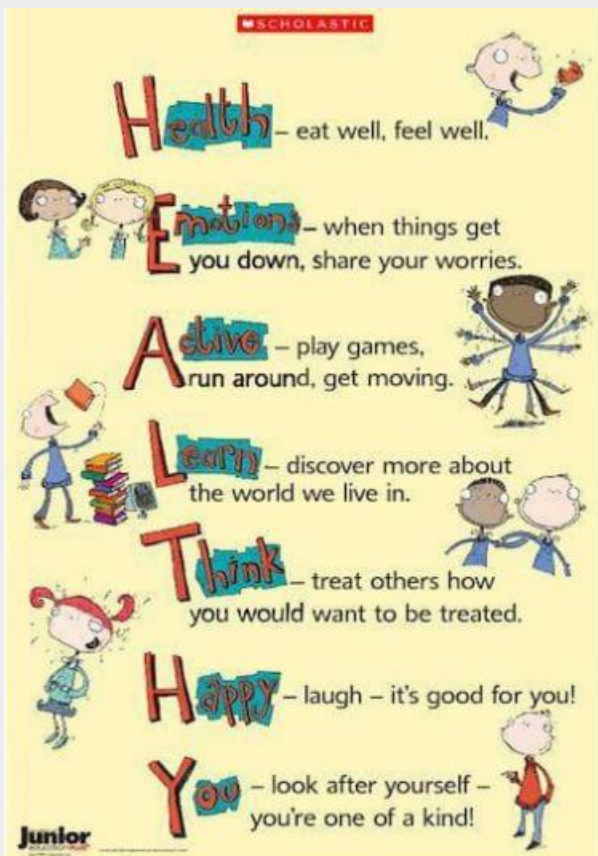
# Student's Creative Corner

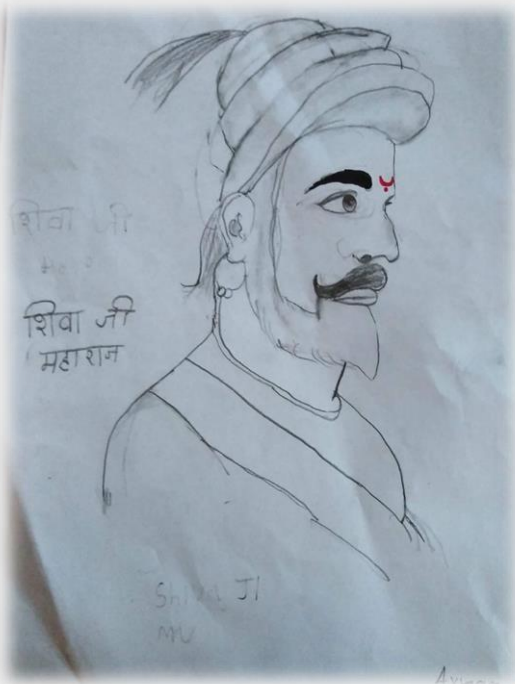

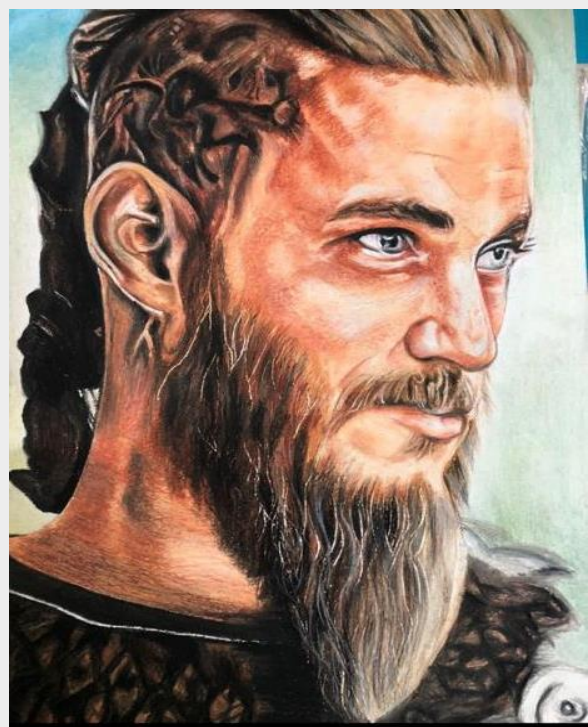
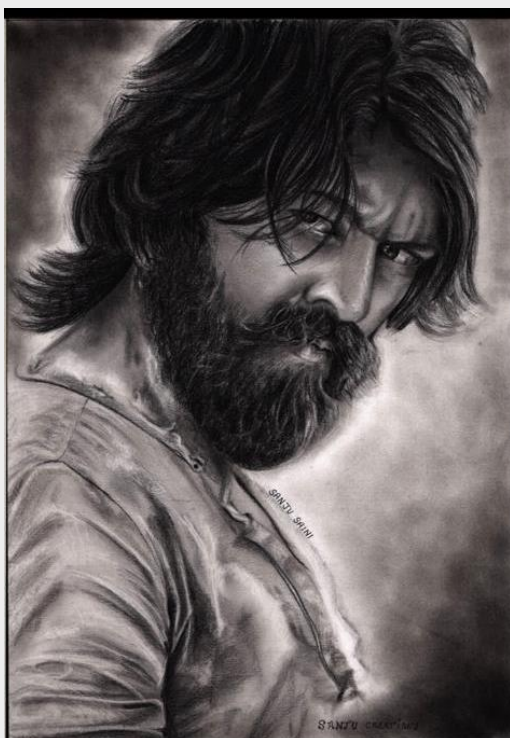
