





### **ACTIVITY 1-AIR**

An air survey was recently conducted by the Air Audit Team under the guidance of Ms. Sonali Suranse at Shri Ram Centennial School. As part of the initiative, students engaged in discussions with the automobile in-charge Mr. Mukesh Chouksey about the different types of fuels used in the school buses. They explored like fuels diesel. petrol, and CNG. understanding their environmental impacts. Students also researched how each fuel contributes to air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions. To showcase their learning, they prepared informative and creative models. The



activity aimed to raise awareness about sustainable fuel choices and promote ecofriendly transportation.

### **ACTIVITY 2- ENERGY**

As part of the Green School Program, the Energy Team conducted an energy audit under the coordination of Ms. Deeksha Kushwah. With guidance from Deepak Singh Sir, the team audited electrical appliances and studied energy consumption in the school. studied rainwater harvesting and groundwater recharge methods for sustainability.

The Waste Management Team of Shri Ram Centennial School, under the guidance of Ms. Sakshi Prereta and Ms. Uma Mishra, carried out a detailed waste audit to ensure a clean and eco-friendly campus. The team focused on proper segregation of wet waste, dry waste, and e-waste with marked bins. clearly Domestic hazardous waste like cleaning agents and paints was identified and safely stored. Biomedical waste such as masks and gloves was carefully disposed of following safety norms. Sanitary waste was collected separately in covered bins to maintain hygiene.

The initiative encourages every child to practice the 3Rs – Reduce, Reuse, Recycle in daily life.

With dedicated efforts, the Waste Management Team is shaping Shri Ram Centennial School into a model green campus.


